

The Kee's Sustainability Efforts

The Kee Resort is continually working to improve the impact we have on people and places. We are committed to reducing our greenhouse gas emissions and to protecting and supporting biodiversity.

As part of that commitment, in 2022 we set ourselves a target of reducing our greenhouse gas emissions from energy, water, and waste per guest night by 2% compared to 2023. We are pleased to report that as of 31st December 2024, we have achieved a reduction in CO2 emissions per guest night of 24.06% compared to 2022. We know that there is more work to for us to do, and in 2025, we are implementing several new initiatives throughout our operation to help us achieve our 2030 goal.

Some of our key goals for 2025 include a reduction of single-use plastics at the hotel by 2% by 31 Dec 2025 and a renovation of our water filtration system to allow us to treat and use well and rainwater to reduce our reliance on municipal water by 31 Dec 2025.

We encourage our valued guests, staff, and visitors to support us by following the reminders we have provided throughout the hotel about saving water and energy, as well as minimizing waste.

We are proud of the fundraising activities, with the support of our guests, we achieved our goal of raising THB 10,100 for Bann Kalim School before the end of 2025. This local school plays an important role in providing an opportunity for the next generation of residents in our community to have a better future. Thanks to donations from our guests, we were able to meet this target.

In 2025, our focus will continue to be on supporting a variety of schools in our community with donations and scholarships during Children's Day and other events. Besides Bann Kalim school, we also support Sai Nam Yen school and the Patong Municipality. We have set a goal of contributing THB 15,000 to support this project, and our staff have participated in a community clean-up day at Bangla Street in April.
